The late John W. Coody's bill-fold was found along the high-way near Spokane Tuesday way near Spokane Tuesday morning by Gene Gilmore, a resident there, who was walking to the store.

Sheriff Lyman Cardwell said that he and State Patrol Ser-geant Wayne Ferguson went to Scokane Tuesday morning to take a look at the scene and pick up the billfold. It contained identification papers, but no money, An intensive investigation has

been underway since Feb. 12 to try to find the killer of John Coody who was found dead with three bullet wounds in the chest

A bulletin went out shortly A billetin went out shortly after the crime describing a youngish man wearing glasses and driving a yellowish-white 1965 Chevrolet. This description came from persons who were near the dump shortly be fore and shortly after the shooting occured. Several leads were received as a result of the bulletin, but as yet none has checked out conclusively,

Involved in the investigation are all officers of the Taney County sheriff's department. State Highway Patrol, Branson Police department and the Prosecuting attorney. Due to some evidence found at the death scene, officers have speculated that robbery may not be a clear-cut motive for the crime.

Funeral services for the vic-tim have been set for Saturday with the time remaining open pending the arrival of two of Coody's sons who live in Calif-ornia. Another son lives in
