At 2:00 A. M. this date an individual who refused to disclose his name phoned this office and stated that on Thursday, 4/3/69, while he was in the vicinity of The Federal Office Building, he overheard a conversation among three men in which one stated, "tomorrow I'll have my .30 - .30 in my office in the Federal Building and it will be loaded."

The individual who called described the three men as follows: all three were well dressed, between twenty and twenty - five years old, white, and clean-cut. The caller could not give a more precise description, he said, because he was afraid the men would see him staring at them, so he did not look directly at them.

The caller, who sounded to be a Negro male, noted the ease with which an individual in the Federal Building could "pick off" Ralph Abernathy as he is speaking in front of City Hall tomorrow. He stated that based on what he overheard that is their intention.
