On instant date, BILL REELE, Sales Représentative, Madison Cadillac, Inc., 341 Union Avenue, Memphis, Tenn. Telephone number at home 323-5235, at business 566-5933 furnished the following information:

RELSE advised that on 5/3/68 an individual indentifying himself as EUGLNE E. SEXTON came to his establishment to buy a Cadillac. RELSE advised that SEXTON was extremely nervous and when checked through GMAC credit, no credit rating could be found.

General conversation with SEXTON revealed that he has been to Atlanta and Birmingham, according to REESE. Also, REESE advised that when SEXTON returned after 6:00 PM on the night of 5/4/68 he was extremely nervous especially upon being told that KING had been shot and killed. REESE advised that SEXTON left abruptly saying he has to go to Bashville, Tenn. and then drove off in his Cadillac that he had purchased.

REESE advised that the reason he was furnishing this information was because SEXTON is allegedly a "deadringer" for JAMES EARL RAY's photographs. Based on Photos of RAY, RELSE feels that SEXTON and RAY are identical. He described RAY as WfM, approximately 37, 5'10", 165 lbs., red sandy hair, and cold sharp black or dark brown eyes. He furnished SEXTON's address as; 3000 Hillboro Road, Nashville, Tenn.
