Rememo of SA ROBERT FITZPATRICK dated 5/8/68.

Records of the Credit Bureau of Nashville as furnished to IC ROBERT M. CALK by [REDACTED], disclose that EUGENE E. SEXTON, 3000 Hillsboro Rd., Nashville, Tenn. has been known to the files since Nov. 1967 at which time he was transferred to Nashville by the Neely-Don, Inc. of New York City, N.Y. as the companies salesman for this area. SEXTON has been employed for 14 years by the New York firm, is married and resides in the Versailles Apts., 3000 Hillsboro Rd. No unfavorable information appears in either the files of the Credit Bureau of Nashville or the Credit Bureau of New York.

RICHARD ROYCE, Maintenance Supervisor, Versailles Apt., 3000 Hillsboro Rd., Nashville, advised the writer on 5/10/68 that SEXTON, his wife and two children, have resided in Apt. 72 since December of 1967, that SEXTON is employed as a salesman for a New York concern and is well regarded in the apartment complex.

ROYCE, after observing a photo of JAMES EARL RAY, stated that SEXTON is definitely not identical with RAY but is a much older man and bears no reasonable resemblance to RAY. He noted that he has visited in the SEXTON apartment several times and has talked with SEXTON on numerous occasions.

No further inquiry being conducted.
