Bureau had just received call from DON G. CUMMINGS, 2733 Elm Hill Pike, Nashville, Tenn. (no phone). CUMMINGS claimed to have information regarding a man who is in Nashville now, will be leaving tonight, who may have been involved in the murder of Dr. King. CUMMINGS advised SA Cajgas he wanted to give this info to the FBI.
