C.N.FOUST, Clarksville, Tennessee, telephonically requested to speak to SA J.F.BIELLRSTEDT. He said that he became acquainted with SA BIEDERSTEDT in connection with an integretation matter several years ago.

6/5/68

FOUST said that he had learned the names of those persons who had shot at him years ago, and found the information furnished to him by a friend, to be accurate. He refused to identify the source of his information.

FOUST FURTHER ADVISED THAT THE SAME PERSON SAID THERE HAD BEEN MONEY OFFERED FOR THE ASSASSINATION OF KING.

FOUST, when he learned that SA BIEDERSTEDT no longer was in the Memphis Division, refused to discuss the matter any further.

LLAD:

At Clarksville, Tennessee, located and interview C.N. FOUST to determine the extent of his knowledge relative to money being offered for the assassination of DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING.
