Paul Houser, Tour Foreman of the U.S. Post Office at 730 S. Main, called to advise he had intercepted some mail addressed to Eric S. Galt, Lorraine Motel. He described the mail as being a record from the American Heritage Company entitled "Invention of the Presidency."
