Mr. WILLIAM MARTINDALE, Civil Rights Section at the Bureau, called this date and advised that the Bureau had received a teletype from Birmingham indicating that subject's lawyer, ARTHUR HANES, had advised Inspector WILLIAM J. HALEY of the Birmingham, Alabama, PD that HANES' wife and secretary lad received numerous harassing and threatening telephone calls. MANES said these calls ranged from silence to outright threats of death. Inspector HALEY had advised the Birmingham Office that the telephone company security office had been notified and were instituting "investigative measures.
