will win an aquital.

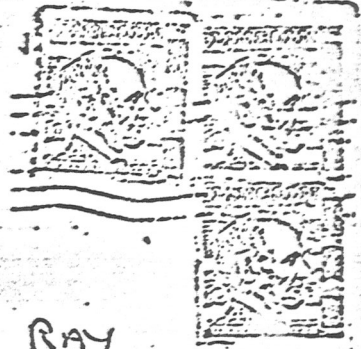
If you are short of
