HE ADVISED THEY SAID IT COULD BE DONE BY A HIGH POWERED RIFLE. [REDACTED] ADVISED THESE MEN STATED THEY WERE MEMBERS OF THE KLAN. [REDACTED] ADVISED THEIR NAMES ARE [REDACTED] ABOUT FORTY YEARS OF AGE, RESIDES AT [REDACTED] PLACE, NASHVILLE, TENN., THE OTHER MAN IS [REDACTED] ABOUT THIRTY-FIVE, RESIDES AT [REDACTED], A SHORT DISTANCE FROM VANDERBILT UNIVERSITY. [REDACTED] ADVISED [REDACTED] LOOKED SIMILAR TO AN ARTIST'S CONCEPTION WHICH APPEARED IN A HUNTSVILLE PAPER. [REDACTED] ADVISED BOTH ARE EMPLOYED BY THE FORD MOTOR GLASS PLATE IN NASHVILLE.
