SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. CIVIL RIGHTS.

*Wednesday morning at 8:30 AM*

MRS EULA MC REYNOLDS, 319 Waterford Road, Silverspring, Md phone 593-0482 telephonically advised writer at 3:40 p.m. this date that she and her husband were at the Howard Johnson Hotel, located on Mariott Parkway, Millford, Conn on Monday and Tuesday nights last and were in the process of checking out when both she and her husband observed a Black Mustang, year 1966 or 1967, believed to be bearing Mass Tags also parked in the Hotel parking lot. In the rear seat of the auto were several rifles some of which were in canvas bags. The trunk of the auto appeared to be broken and did not fit down properly. The owner of the car was also in the process of checking out. He was described as a white male, age 35, height 6', weight 170, light brown hair, fair complexion but slightly sun-burned, wearing plad shirt (color unknown) color of trousers unknown, carrying one bag.


MC REYNOLDS stated that she stayed in room #29 and that the owner of the car stayed in the next room on the right of hers.

MC REYNOLDS stated that on registering at the Hotel that all applicants are required to state the tag number, state, and make and model of auto.
