At approximately 12:35 AM, I telephonically furnished the above information to Supervisor CHARLES HARDING of the Atlanta Office and requested that he east got be in touch with the Atlanta Airport and coordinate with the Birmingham Office in the event the above flight was diverted and, in any event, to make appropriate arrangements for this envelope to be delivered to the New Orleans Office.
