[REDACTED] (Protect, Reliable) advised on 4/15/68 that one JOHN ALAN FEDUCCIA had applied for a Costa Rican visa on 4/11/68. Upon reviewing FEDUCCIA'S visa application and U.S. passport photo, [REDACTED] felt there was a strong resemblance between his photo and the composite photo of the unknown subject wanted for the murder of MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. [REDACTED] advised that FEDUCCIA did not come to the Costa Rican Embassy with his visa application but sent his application by messenger. [REDACTED] furnished the following background information from FEDUCCIA'S application:

[REDACTED] advised that Costa Rican visa #070, date of issue 4/11/68, was assigned to FEDUCCIA. Also, his application showed that he had been issued Guatemalan visa #603 on 4/9/68.

[REDACTED] further advised that FEDUCCIA'S application was accompanied by a visa application for CHARLES FREDERICK WALKER, DOB 12/27/04, POB Ohio, USA, U.S. Passport # 288378. WALKER was also connected with the University of Michigan

WFO will review Passport records re FEDUCCIA to further identify him.
