Mrs. HAROLD (ELEANOR) HILL, 3002 Pearl Drive, Suitland, Maryland said the photograph of ERNEST STARVO GALT which appeared in the "Washington Post" on 4/18/68 looks like a photograph of a person she met several times in the fall of 1967 at a hillbilly type night club, the "Surf Club" in the Colmar Manor area of Bladensburg, Maryland. <sup>she</sup> recall having ever seen him there with anyone accompanying him. He usually wore plaid short sleeve

Mrs. HILL said this person asked her to dance several times and she refused as she is married. He also offered to buy her a beer which she declined. She added she met him in September, October or November, 1967 on Friday or Saturday evenings. The extent of her conversations with him were his asking her to dance and her refusal. She added her mother HELEN CHATLIN, 3002 Pearl Drive, Suitland, Maryland also saw this person but she has <sup>with</sup> not discussed the photograph which appeared in the "Post" with her mother as her mother is a cab driver for the Washington Cab Company.

She said a person known as "NELLIE" works behind the bar at the Surf Club. The manager of the club is CHICK HILL who plays in the band there.

He usually wore plaid short sleeve shirts with blue plaid or small checks design. She added he was a gentleman and talked very nice to her. Mrs. HILL said she believes this person was at the Surf Club the Friday or Saturday evening dances she attended during Sept&amber, October or November, 1967. She said he was there about two or three times when she was there. He always appeared clean and neat. She said she does not know his name. She added he tried to get a date with her but she refused.

She said a person known as "BILLY" works behind the bar at the Surf Club. The manager of the club is FRANK HILL who plays in the back there.
