On afternoon of 4/21/68 Mr. David Eccleston, producer of radio station at the American University on Massachusetts and Nebraska Avenue N.W. WDC called WFO concerning a fan letter which had been sent to their Country Music Program handled by Spots Wood, disc jockey. The letter was signed William John Willard and his address was; 131 South Madiera St. Balt. 31, Md.

The letter did not have any date on it and had been at the radio station approximately a week. The handwriting appears to be that of a child.

Eccleston said he was furnishing this information to the FBI for whatever action deemed advisable since one of the aliases used by James Earl Ray, suspect in MURKIN was William John Willard.
