VIRGINIA GUY, Flair News Service, 1028 Connecticut Avenue, N. W., Washington, D. C., and attorney, PHILIP HIRSCHKOP, 110 North Royal, Alexandria, Virginia, appeared at Washington Field Office on this date.

Mrs. GUY brought with her a series of photographs taken in Atlanta, Georgia, on the day of the funeral of Dr. MARTIN LUTHER KING. These photographs depicted several individuals standing on an overpass which Mrs. GUY stated overlooked the funeral rally. The pictures were taken approximately ten minutes prior to the funeral procession passing this point.

Mrs. GUY pointed out one individual whom whe believed may be identical to ERIC STARVO GALT. She also had blown up shots of this individual.

SAs CREAMER and JOHN BLAZEK observed these photographs and concluded that they did not resemble subject's photograph as it appears on the wanted poster. Mrs. GUY's attorney also was of the opinion that this individual was much younger than the subject.

Mrs. GUY did not wish to release her photographs and she advised that they would be available in the future if a better likeness is obtained and appears to be the same as the individual in her picture. Afrite Su and But + KC ME + KC ME + KC
