may have recently been issued a passport and the record thereof is not yet in Washington, the writer arranged through Mr. EDWARD STOKEN of the Passport O'fice to send a teletype message to all its Passport Agencies. The Passport Office on 4-19-68 also telephoned its Agency in Honolulu to check on RAY, with negative results. Mr. ROBERT D. JOHNSON, Acting Director, Passport Office telephonically advised SA HASER on 4-19-68 that the Agencies had all teletyped Washington that their records are negative as to RAY.

Mr. JOHNSON also issued instructions whereby the weekend Duty Officer of the Passbort Office, Mrs. NELL ALLEN, was alerted concerning RAY and fix instructions to all Passbort Agencies to refer immediately to the nearest FBI Office any information received concerning RAY and intended travel. Mrs. ALLEN was told to telephone the Duty Agent at WFO concerning any information received. SA HASER alerted the Night Supervisor's office in WFO concerning this matter.
