On 4/13/68, GIRARD HIRSHMAN advised that the artists sketch of the killer of MARTIN LUTHER KING, Jr. which appears in the Washington Post of 4/13/68, closely resembles an individual presently in Ward 4-East of Cafritz Hospital.

According to HIRSHMAN, who was also in this Ward at Cafritz (Psychiatric), this individual whom he recalls as FNU ANDERSON arrived about three days after the death of Dr. KING.

HIRSHMAN stated he does not have an address in WASHINGTON but is staying at a friends house and can be reached on LI3-8420. He did not give the address except it was at 13th and H Sts., NE., WDC.
