

FBI Makes TV Appeal ^c in Search for Ray

The FBI appealed on national television last night for any information regarding fugitive James Earl Ray, charged with conspiracy and murder in the slaying of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.

The FBI said Ray, alias Eric Starvo Galt, was armed and "must be considered extremely dangerous." Earlier the FBI said the search "is going along with all possible vigor." Ray, 40, 1967 escaper from the Missouri state prison, was named to the FBI's list of most wanted criminals Saturday.
