On March 3, 1964, informant advised as follows:

(E&R/AAB) MARINA with presumably GEORGE BOUHE, ANNA and ANNA's son named PAUL? General conversation in which GEORGE spoke to the child concerning his breakfast. GEORGE complimented MARINA on the house and said he likes same. GEORGE told MARINA that he does all work in his home now and likes it. GEORGE spoke concerning JEANNE DE MOHRENSCHILDT and the fact that she worked or works for Neiman-Marcus. GEORGE also apparently mentioned concerning trip by DE MOHRENSCHILDTs. MARINA spoke concerning THORNE, who apparently told her that there was no hurry. MARINA also said that she has no money. GEORGE again spoke on DE MOHRENSCHILDT, who is a very pleasant fellow and who apparently gave GEORGE his card, saying that should GEORGE ever need FBI in Washington, to call him, DE MOHRENSCHILDT (not too clear). GEORGE mentioned that he reads the "New York Times", which is the best source of information which he has. He also mentioned that he has heard somewhere that MARINA had some sort of a lover.

On March 2, 1964, informant advised as follows:

5:14 P.M.: (E&R/AAB) MARINA, JUNE, HEITMAN, and BOGUSLAV, general conversation. MARINA served soft drinks.

5:54 P.M. (E&R/AAB) Mrs. FORD and MARINA, conversation concerning MARTIN primarily. Women discussed presents given by MARTIN to MARINA. MARINA mentioned she does not see why she has to pay out \$5,000. She also mentioned that Secret Service and FBI know everything about the whole affair.

9:02 P.M. (E&R/AAB) FORD, Mrs. FORD and MARINA. Women discussed LEVINE and his attempt to contact MARINA. MARINA said that GEORGE DOUHE told her he did not know that LEVINE was asked not to come her again since things are still unsettled. FORDS and MARINA continue to discuss her business, including presumably the signing of contracts. FORD asked whether ILYA MAMANTOV presumably offered to translate contract for her. FORD talked to MAMANTOV by telephone while women talked. FORD reported to the women on his conversation with MAMANTOV. Question of MC KENZIE being expensive attorney was brought up. MARINA apparently reaffirmed her desire to retain MC KENZIE.

MARINA, JUNE, Mrs. FORD and her son GREGORY.  
(Mostly Russian). (AAB)

MARINA said she's busy the entire day changing the babies. She spoke re feeding babies and her dislike for the bottle. MARINA asked Mrs. FORD whether there was any mail. She offered JUNE a cookie and admonished her not to make so much noise. Women spent much time in discussing furnishings for MARINA's house, the children with their illnesses and babies feeding. MARINA mentioned that she would like to have a woman so that JUNE can be taken care of. She also mentioned someone who speaks Russian though born in China. Women apparently tried to put the children to sleep.

Later apparently FORD and Mrs. FORD visited MARINA. Mrs. FORD, FORD and MARINA apparently discussed a reply to Mrs. MARGUERITE OSWALD, who's interested in MARINA and would like to see her and the children.

Mrs. FORD then read translation of LEVINE's letter, addressed to MARINA, in which LEVINE mentioned that he does not have address of MARINA's house; that he's asking MARINA to think things slowly; that he has told the Meredith Press re: need for the baby sitter while MARINA will be writing a book and that they O.K. payments up to \$100.00 per week for a baby sitter and that he's ready to come and see MARINA as soon as he can. LEVINE also, apparently, knows that it will be impossible to do anything until new manager and attorney will be able to conduct talks.

(English) Unidentified Baptist minister to MARINA. Asked MARINA about church affiliation, described the church as the one with a spire which you can see when you are coming on the express. Said it is a big brick building and the largest church in town and is on Greenville. The minister asked whether MARINA started church out here anywhere. MARINA replied she attended church in Dallas. Minister spoke concerning religious beliefs and asked if MARINA goes by the New Testament. He invited MARINA to visit their Sunday School where they have classes for every age. He mentioned it is a Baptist church. He also said that there is a Baptist church in Moscow. MARINA said she has friends living close by in Richardson and that's why she decided to reside here. The minister again invited MARINA to visit Sunday School and see what type program they have. He stated it is a nice town, there is no liquor here and it is a clean community with good neighbors. MARINA mentioned that people from number [REDACTED] named SMITH or MC CORMICK visited her. MARINA said that she is lonely since she is living by herself. The minister said that she needs some social life and can't live just in four walls. MARINA mentioned that she talks to the FBI and other people. MINISTER replied that she needs friends of her own age and it would be good for her. He mentioned that he has three boys and two girls, one of his sons being age 23. The minister thanked MARINA for privilege of talking and expressed hope to see her and the children. *4*

(R/AAB) Mrs. FORD to MARINA. Very brief conversation, during which Mrs. FORD suggested MARINA call someone about A.M. She then said goodbye. *4*

MC KENZIE said that he has to talk to ROBERT and that HENRY BAER is on his way to see ROBERT. MC KENZIE mentioned he will talk to MARINA tonight or come and talk to her in the morning. He then said that MARGUERITE OSWALD tried to enter the courtroom where RUBY's trial is held, this morning. He said that reporters may bring MARGUERITE OSWALD to the house and come with her. He told MARINA to advise MARGUERITE OSWALD that she would be glad to talk to her without the reporters and to let them stay outside. MC KENZIE said that BOGUSLAV and HEITMAN will probably drive her to Fort Worth as BOGUSLAV is going back to New York and for her to go ahead and have a good time. He asked whether she found the name of a pediatrician for JUNE and RACHEL and told her to call his office should she need him. He explained that the office would know where to find him. ♀

Mrs. FORD visited MARINA, indulged in general talk about children, present for DECLAN, that is, table lighter and ash tray which Mrs. FORD will pick up for MARINA, and plans for MARINA to stay at FORDS' house while they will be in Washington. Mrs. FORD mentioned that MARINA can use their room. MARINA said that there should be no trouble with children. ♀


