SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY

Reference is made to serial #819 of instant file (Dallas airtel to Bureau 11/26/63, attention: Mechanical Section, enclosing 5 rolls 35mm exposed film. Request made to process and to make 3 prints of each exposure, letter size, and return all to Dallas Office. Bureau was advised Dallas will furnish one copy of each print to the local representative of Secret Service after prints examined by Dallas Office for content.)

On 11/28/63 BOB STEWART, Secret Service, made telephonic inquiry as to whether prints previously promised them were ready. STEWART was advised prints not yet received from Bureau and estimated return would be about 12/4/63. STEWART was advised that if his Bureau needed this material immediately, attention was being directed to fact that Insp. SAWYER, Dallas Police Dept., had film of all evidence turned over to FBI.
