On 12/8/63 CHESTER NORTON telephonically advised that he resides at 1008 Sharondale, Fort-Worth, Texas. He stated that his wife, MARIE NORTON, had been waiting for him in the Razorback Club on the west side of Fort Worth on the night of 11/22/63 after the assassination of President KENNEDY.

He claimed that his wife said that BERNARD WEISSMAN had been in the club with another male individual. They discussed having just been released from the Air Force fairly recently and discussed having been to Cuba. NORTON said that he did not hear any of the conversation because about the time he came in and joined his wife, WEISSMAN and his male companion departed.

NORTON said that his wife could furnish descriptions of the men. He further advised that they have no home telephone and both work and that she could be reached at Bond's Department Store in Fort Worth where she is Manager in the Ladies' Wear Department.
