MARTINDALE volunteered that this was a promotion for WILLIAMS who previously worked as a reporter for JACK ROBERTSON, Chief of the Dallas, Texas Bureau of Fairchild Publications, located at 1309 Main St., Dallas, Texas.

For the information of Dallas and St. Louis, Fairchild Publications, Inc. is a large publishing house in NYC. There are numerous criminal and security type references to this company in the NYO indices, which is to be expected because of travel by employees to Soviet and other foreign countries;
