Anonymous letter

The following letter written in the Spanish language with envelope addressed to Office of Federal Police of Investigation, FBI, Dallas, Texas, postmarked at Monterrey N.L., Mexico, date illegible, and letter headed Monterrey N.L., Dec. 9, '63, was received at this office on 12/11/63. A free translation of this letter in the English language follows:

"Federal Police of Investigation
FBI
Dallas, Texas

"I wrote you the 3rd day of December, 1963, a letter about the crime. This letter is coordinated with that one. I discovered that there is a woman in this crime. This young lady is one that is receiving money from the Cuban Ambassador, one named Lechuga. First lover of Jack Ruby is an artist of the theater called Tere. She is tall and light complected. She is a lioness, and it seems she has a beauty spot. She wears red shoes and a hair switch. This young lady _____ much. She has all that you are looking for. As I told you in the other letter, Jack Ruby on the day of the crime used an automatic pistol." (The writer implies that Oswald and Ruby acted together in the assassination.) "I will give you my address if you care to answer me. I am a prophet. I am not drunk."
