On 12-12-63 Mrs. MARY GILPIN, 210 Petroleum Rd., Wichita Falls, Tex.
was contacted by SA CHARLES T. BROWN JR.; Mrs. GILPIN related the following:

Shortly after the assassination of JOHN F. KENNEDY her mother daughter
Mrs. MAGGIE GILPIN informed her that Mrs. OSWALD had worked for her
uncle, Mr. PHILLIPS, at Vernon, Tex. caring for Mr. PHILLIPS aged brother.
According to Mrs. GILPIN her daughter stated Mrs. OSWALD had tried to borrow
\$600. from Mr. PHILLIPS in order to get her son LEE HARVEY OSWALD out of Russia.
And Mr. PHILLIPS refused whereupon Mrs. OSWALD became profane and Mr. PHILLIPS
discharged her. Mrs. GILPIN stated this occurred in about April 1962. She
advised she did not recall Mr. PHILLIPS first name but he was well known in
Vernon he operates a business.

NOTE: SA JAMES H. DAVIS advises he has already interviewed Mr. PHILLIPS
at Vernon, Tex. in relation to Mrs. OSWALD's employment.
