It was concluded that the questioned writing on specimens Q6 and Q7 was prepared by the writer of specimens Q4 and Q5. previously submitted.

The envelope, Q6, is a self-seal envelope manufactured by the U. S. Envelope Company, 21 Cypress, Springfield 2, Massachusett No watermarks or other identifying characteristics were found in the paper comprising Q7 to determine its source.

The ink writing on Q6 and Q7 was prepared with a ball-point pen.

The stamp on specimen Q6 was torn from a booklet.

Specimens Q6 and Q7 will be returned to the New Orleans Office by separate report. Photographs are retained.
