- Q6** Envelope postmarked "NEW ORLEANS LA. 18 DEC 9 1963 7 00PM" bearing handwritten address "Editor Times Picayune Paper 615 North Street New Orleans Louisiana" with return address "St. Charles Ave. New Orleans, La."
- Q7** Accompanying one-page handwritten letter dated 12/9/63, beginning "Editor, The Time Picayune We as over..." and ending "...all our lives in this city"

Result of examination:

It was concluded that the questioned writing on specimens Q6 and Q7 was prepared by the writer of specimens Q4 and Q5, previously submitted.

The envelope, Q6, is a self-seal envelope manufactured by the U. S. Envelope Company, 31 Cypress, Springfield 2, Massachusetts. No watermarks or other identifying characteristics were found in the paper comprising Q7 to determine its source.

The ink writing on Q6 and Q7 was prepared with a ball-point pen.

The stamp on specimen Q6 was torn from a booklet.

Specimens Q6 and Q7 will be returned to the New Orleans Office by separate report. Photographs are retained.
