## OSWALD 'Doctor' Waited In Vain

An FBI agent, wearing the robes of a doctor, waited in vain at Lee Harvey Oswald's bedside for a deathbed confession that never came. The Times Herald added Saturday.

The agent never received consciousness, and the walls that could have renewed all doubt were closed as to whether Oswald killed President John F. Kennedy or ever spoke.

The agent was on hand at Parkland Hospital on Nov. 24 during the one hour and 45 minutes doctors worked to save the life of the 24-year-old avowed Marxist who was felled by a pistol shot fired by Jack Ruby in the basement of City Hall.

Sources said the agent never left the side of the accused assassin while doctors worked on his aid in the emergency room and later performed emergency surgery.

He was reportedly dressed and carried several times but no one should be surprised if he was seen. Doctors' dressings have a tendency to do just that.

He was brought to Parkland at 11:45 a.m. by ambulance and was pronounced dead following surgery on a second floor surgical suite at 1:15 p.m.

Oswald, during the 48 hours he was in police custody, never advised the naming of the Presid-
