On 12/19/63, Mr. JACK MOLLINS, retired civilian government employee, (procurement officer, GS-14, retired 8/60), residing 3675 Dorisa Avenue, Oakland, California, (telephone NE 8-7088), telephonically advised that a friend of his (whom he considered reliable), who is an employee of the U. S. Post Office, Cypress and Grand Streets, Oakland, California, recently confided to him that in handling mail at the Post Office, she observed two pieces of mail bearing a handwritten return address indicating the sender was the "LEE OSWALD MARKSMANSHIP FUND," from somewhere in New Mexico. She was unable to furnish MOLLINS with the exact address of origin or destination, other than the fact that both pieces were destined to the same individual at Napa, California.

MOLLINS advised he would not furnish the identity of the postal employee for fear of jeopardizing the source's job and that the source was afraid to appear too interested in the mail for the same reason. MOLLINS was advised to maintain contact with the postal employee to obtain further identifying information re captioned organization.

San Francisco indices contain no references to MOLLINS or captioned organization.
