Re San Antonio airtel to the Bureau dated 12/17/63.

The following investigation was conducted at Colorado Springs, Colorado by SA EDWARD J. RODGERS, JR.:

On 12/26/63 A/IC BILLY FIELDS, Personnel Orders, Ent AFB, advised that a search of locator records for personnel for Air Defense Command (ADC), North American Air Defense Command (NORAD), and Base Personnel, Ent AFB, failed to locate any information indicating A. VILLARREAL, S. MARTINEZ, or FNU BELMARES are located at Ent AFB.

On 12/27/63 A/2C NEAL COOK, Director of Airmen Personnel, Records Division, Air Force Academy advised that he could locate no record whatsoever of above three persons.

On 1/3/64 A/IC LLOYD FRIESEDAHL, Base Locator, Lowry AFB, Denver, Colorado, advised SA RAYMOND J. FOX that base locator files at Lowry AFB contained no record regarding VILLARREAL, MARTINEZ or BELMARES.

AT LAREDO, TEXAS: Recontact officials of Trans Texas Airlines (TTA) and examine passengers manifest of Flight 292 on 10/5/63 and obtain therefrom information regarding origin, military order number or other pertinent information concerning VILLAREAL, MARTINEZ or BELMARES in order to determine their ultimate destination. It is noted all logical air installations at Colorado Springs, Colorado, have been contacted and were unable to locate any record of these three airmen.

Will also determine whether all three purchased transportation through use of a Government Transport Request and if affirmative will thereafter locate through TTA the airline copy of the Government Transport Request for further information on these three airmen.
