On 1/7/64 Rev. BONAVENTURE CRAVLEY, Faculty Member, Bellarmine College, Louisville, Ny., telaphonically advised SA WARREN L. WALSH as follows:

He has just returned from a Christmas vacation visit with his family in Lansing, Michigan. During the occasion of his visit, he was talking with Dr. J. N. GALLACHER, a dentist having offices at 102 East Klm Street, Lansing, Michigan. During the conversation they discussed a long-time friend, Mrs. J. M. OSWALD, 419 North Shiawassee Street, Apartment 4, Owosso, Michigan. During the conversation Dr. GALLACHER said that after the assassination of President KENNEDY by LEE HARVEY OSWALD, no relation to Mrs. J. M. OSWALD, Mrs. OSWALD, because of her name, received the expected crank calls and she had referred the matter to the local police. Dr. GALLACHER also commented that about a month before the assassination of the President, Mrs. OSWALD had received an anonymous phone call, the caller requesting to know if she had relatives in Texas. According to Reverend CRAWLEY, she does not have relatives in Texas.

Rev. CRAWLEY felt the info about the anonymous phone call received by Mrs. OSWALD approximately a month before the assassination of the President should be brought to the attention of the FBI in the event the info might possibly be of some value in connection with the investigation the FBI conducted into the assassination of President KENNEDY.
