Following investigation was conducted by SAS RICHARD E. HARRISON and
PAUL SCOTT.

On 1/25/64 Mr. JOEL MCCREY, Manager, Downtown YMCA was interviewed relative to any records he might have for long distance telephone calls received or made by LEE HARVEY OSWALD, during his stay at the YMCA @ the night of October 3-4, 1963. MCCREY advised no telephones are maintained in the rooms at the YMCA, and when a long distance call is received, the room of the recipient is buzzed, and thereupon the recipient would go to a telephone in the ~~###~~ which is an extension for the main number at the YMCA, to answer the call. He advised no record is kept of long distance calls made to the YMCA, and stated guests are not permitted to make long distance calls out of the YMCA. MCCREY advised the main number ~~###~~ for the YMCA is Riverside 2-3251, and the extension on the sixth floor, where OSWALD resided is extension 19. He advised there is only one other public telephone on the sixth floor, which has the number Riverside 2-0722, and would be the only ~~###~~ telephone on that floor that OSWALD could have called out on.
