SUBJECT: LEE HARVEY OSWALD, aka

Sec. Chief WILLIAM A. BRANIGAN telephonically contacted Dallas, 2:45 PM, this date, and advised that he was reading from the notebook taken from OSWALD and quoted the name of "FBI Agent HASTY" with license number "MV 8605, 1114 Commerce Street, Dallas". He stated that he noted two other instances where it was reported that the license number was one digit off. Mr. BRANIGAN asked clarification of this matter.

Mr. BRANIGAN was advised that the digits were correct; however, the letters were one letter off as the correct license number was NU 8605. Mr. BRANIGAN advised this was sufficient clarification.

With regard to obtaining typewriting specimens from the machine owned by Mrs. PAINE, which were submitted in a previous communication Mr. BRANIGAN advised that the Laboratory had informed him that the machine was a Smith-Corona; therefore, specimens should be obtained from that make of machine.
