Re Dallas teletype to NY, 1/30/64.

On 2/3/64, Miss KATHLEEN SPOLLEN, Secretary to JOSEPH KELLY, Collector, Bureau of Customs, NYC, advised that -- all information contained in their files re OSWALD had been previously furnished to the FBI.

On 2/4/64, THOMAS FARRELLY, Assistant to the Collector, Bureau of Customs, advised that under the customs regulations in effect on 6/13/62, the date of subject's re-entry into the US, it would have been necessary for OSWALD to have declared all articles in his possession that he purchased abroad regardless of the cost. This would, therefore, have included subject's camera referred to in re teletype.

It is to be noted that OSWALD's customs declaration failed to reflect a listing for any camera purchased abroad and in fact, subject did not list any articles in the declaration form.
