On 2/6/64, [redacted], who is employed at [redacted], expressed at the Dallas Office and stated that [redacted] is concerned about [redacted] MAXWELL MARTIN, the son of [redacted] Mrs. MAXINE MARTIN, of Lawton, Oklahoma.

MAXWELL MARTIN is a WMA about 21, 6' 2", 175 lbs., brown hair dyed red, slender build; father, WILLIAM L. MARTIN, retired from Army and lives in town outside Ft. Riley, Kansas; mother, Mrs. MAXINE MARTIN, employed at Ft. Sill, Oklahoma. During the summer of 1963, MAXWELL MARTIN associated with a boy known as SAMMY SANDERS, a WMA about 25, 5' 10", 150 lbs., black hair, and supposed to be from Wichita, Kansas.

During the summer of 1963, MAXWELL MARTIN and SAMMY SANDERS claim they made several trips in and out of Mexico, and [redacted] heard MARTIN mention the island of "Cesonel." [redacted] have no idea what the two boys were doing there in Mexico, or whether they were ever actually in Mexico, but they have wondered whether they may have been involved in some violation of the laws of the United States.

[redacted] read a newspaper article indicating that a charter flight service executive in Dallas reported that a man resembling LEE HARVEY OSWALD inquired last summer about a flight to the island of Cozumel. This newspaper article caused them to be more concerned as to the activities of MAXWELL MARTIN. They know that MAXWELL MARTIN and SAMMY SANDERS were in Dallas the week-end of 11/16/63, and stayed at the Meadowbrook Hotel on Hines Blvd. in Dallas, but they were not in Dallas at the time President Kennedy was killed. [redacted] furnished a handwritten story, written by [redacted] in which she sets forth events that has made her suspicious of [redacted] stated he and [redacted] have never heard MAXWELL MARTIN mention the name of LEE HARVEY OSWALD; and they do not suspect MARTIN or SANDERS of being mixed up in any way with OSWALD; but they do wonder why the boys went to Mexico. MARTIN is presently attending Cameron College in Lawton, Oklahoma.
