On 2/2/64 I obtained the following evidence from Captain GEORGE DOUGHTY of the Dallas Police Department, Dallas, Texas: which evidence was located in the Crime Laboratory at Parkland Hospital, Dallas, Texas:

- 1 pair of black shoes
- 1 pair of black trousers
- 1 gray flannel shirt
- 1 T shirt
- 1 black sweater
- 1 pair of black socks

I signed a receipt dated 2/2/64 from Captain DOUGHTY and agreed that this evidence would remain in my personal custody until the time it was returned to the Dallas PD. I delivered this evidence to Washington, D. C., on the same date, where it was retained in my personal custody.

On 2/6/64 this evidence was exhibited before the Congressional Commission headed by Chief Justice EARL WARREN. This was for the purpose of identification by Mrs. MARINA OSWALD, who was testifying before that Commission. Prior to taking this evidence to the Commission, in the right side pocket of the trousers a small slip of paper bearing the following numbers was noted:
