In connection with my interview of Colonel J. E. WILKETH of Fort Worth on January 13, 1964, the results of which are set forth on an FD 302 as page 217 of the report of SA ROBERT P. GENBERLING dated January 22, 1964, the following information is set forth with respect to the fact that line 5, paragraph 3, first word is reflected as Mexico whereas it should have been reflected as Moscow:

I recall dictating this FD 302 on the telephone from the Fort Worth residence agency where I am assigned. It is my recollection that it was dictated as Noscow. This dictation was performed on January 15, 1964. I did not review the typed FD 302 prior to its inclusion in a report in view of the expeditious nature of the investigation and the fact that same was being included in a report dated January 22, 1964.

Upon receiving the original FD 302 for approval and initialling, I noticed that the word Mexico should have been Ecscow and called this to the attention of SA ROBERT P. GENBERLING in order that the Bureau could be advised and appropriate corrections made.
