SEVENTEEN LAST ADVISED HE HAD JUST VISITED THE OFFICE OF THE NO HAIRY COUNTY INDEPENDENT, A WEEKLY NEWSPAPER, AND THERE THE ADITOR AND PUBLISHER WILBUR WRIGHT DISCLOSED THAT HE, WRIGHT, HAD JUST RECEIVED FROM ELIS LEE ROBESON, RR TWO, SELMER, TENN., A NOTEBOOK IN WHICH ROBESON SAID IN APRIL, SIXTYTHREE, HE HAD PICKED UP OSWALD AND DRIVEN HIM AROUND AND OSWALD HAD A PISTOL AND A CP FLAG OR STICKER AND THE TWO DROVE BY GENERAL WALKER'S HOME. ADAMS SAID THIS SEEKS TO HIM TO BE A STEP ON THE PART OF ROBESON TO SEEK PUBLICITY FOR HIMSELF AND THAT WHAT IS IN THE NOTEBOOK COULD HAVE BEEN OBTAINED FROM VARIOUS NEWSPAPERS. HE SAID ROBESON AND HIS FATHER, A REVEREND ROBESON, ARE NOTED AS BIG TALKERS. ELIS LEE ROBESON TOLD WRIGHT HE HAD BEEN INTERVIEWED BY THE FBI. SUTEL WHETHER ROBESON HAS BEEN INTERVIEWED AND WHETHER IT IS DESIRED THAT HE BE INTERVIEWED OR REINTERVIEWED.
