You can answer me through the Secret Service men. If you have the clothing and wish the \$100 send it in. If it is at the Miller Funeral Home, I could pick it up there at Fort Worth. If it is with the FBI or Secret Service, or any other agency, your lette authorizing me to have it might be good enough to get the clothing.
