FOR INFO SAN ANTONIO, BUREAU IS ENDEAVORING TO LOCATE AND INTERVIEW OSBORNE-BOWEN, WHO IS BELIEVED TO HAVE SAT NEXT TO OSWALD ON BUS TRIP VIA RED ARROW LINE FROM NUEVO LAREDO TO MEXICO CITY ON SEPT. TWENTYSIX, LAST. BUREAU INSTRUCTS THAT IF LOCATED ADVISE BUREAU IMMEDIATELY SO THAT DETAILED INSTRUCTIONS FOR INTERVIEW MAY BE FORWARDED.
