SUBJECT: ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT
JOHN F. KENNEDY
NOVEMBER 22, 1963
DALLAS, TEXAS

At 2:30 P.M., this date Inspector MALLEY telephonically requested MR. LOEFFLER to provide the Bureau with a verbal description of the assassination scene, indicating the width of the street and sidewalks, the angles of the streets, the heights of the buildings at the intersection of Elm and Houston Streets in Dallas, and a general verbal description of Dealey Plaza. This description should reflect the declining angle on Elm Street. To accomplish that, we would also appreciate it if you could provide us with a contour map of the immediate area."
