## Ex-Resident Bringing Russian Wife, Child

Lee Harvey Oswald, 22-year-old former Fort Worth resident who went to the Soviet Union in 1959, is on his way home with his Russian wife and infant.

Oswald, who soon after his arrival in Russia turned in his passport at the American embassy in Moscow, said at the time he would "never return to the United States for any reason," is reportedly returning by boat.

A U. S. embassy spokesman in Moscow said Friday that Oswald applied for a passport last fall, asking the Soviets for exit permits for his wife and child at the same time.

Formalities were completed last week, according to the Associated Press, and the three left Moscow by train. They were to continue their trip by ship, but the embassy spokesman did not know which ship or from where it sailed.

Oswald, a former Marine, is the brother of R. L. Oswald of 713 Davenport. His mother, Mrs. Marguerite Oswald, lives in Boyd.
