The first letter is a handwritten letter on stenographic-type note paper dated February 24, 1964, signed "Sam Gantry" which was received by the Dallas Police Department in an envelope postmarked February 27, 1964, at Chicago, Illinois, and bearing a return address of "Sam Gantry, Chicago, Illinois 60601.

On the reverse side of the envelope appears the handwritten inscription "Please Mr. Mailman Hurry Up Or Else".

The second letter, which was also received by the Dallas Police Department, is a typewritten letter, unsigned, postmarked at New York, New York, on February 28, 1964.

The reverse side of the envelope containing this letter reflects the notation "D.N. 660 West 39th Street, New York City, N.Y."
