On 4/11/64, a woman identifying herself as Mrs. Mark Martin of Tulsa, Oklahoma, called, apparently long distance, and stated he that she was working on a garden clubprogram and that each of the Women in the club was to contribute something to the program by finding out what they could about the assassination of President Kennedy. Mrs. Martin stated that she wanted to ask a question. I advised her that I could furnish her no information. She then stated that the information she sought had appeared in the paper. I then told her she could consult the paper. She then stated she wanted to know which paper in the United States it appeared in. I told her she could consult the newspaper more files. She then stated she wanted to know if "the gung" had a serial number on it. I told her I could furnish her no information. She then asked he wanted to talk to him and why did she want to know if he were in town.
