SUBJECT: LEE HARVEY OSWALD, aka  
IS - R - CUBA

Inspector JAMES R. MALLEY called at 4:10 PM today and stated there is some indication that the group may be down this weekend and that he (MALLEY) should know by tomorrow whether or not this is definite. He stated he has been trying to see RANKIN and did learn through his secretary that the Commission is meeting this afternoon and they are supposed to be discussing this angle.

I advised that in connection with the WALKER residence, etc., we will get that material off today to Bureau. In this connection, we couldn't get in touch with WALKER as he is out of town. We can identify the house.

MALLEY instructed that it be sent in as soon as possible, and he will take it up with the Commission.

RICHARD ROGGE then dictated a part of the Director's testimony as follows:

"This was being done in the early stages of the OSWALD case, and almost as soon as the report would reach the Dallas Police Department, the Chief of Police or one of the representatives of the Department would go on TV or radio and relate the findings of the FBI, giving information such as the identification of the gun and other items of physical evidence."
