made and furnished to him at a later date.

Inspector GAUTHIER also advised that with respect to the request for scheduled drawings of the first and third floors of the police building, it is his understanding that these

drawings may not be available. He stated that if this is a fact, the Bureau should be advised today so that a crew could be sent to Dallas to obtain the desired drawings over Saturday and Sunday of this week.
