SUBJECT: Lee Harvey Oswald, info concerning.

Joseph L. Bernd, an instructor in the Dept. of Gov't at SMU, called this office about 9:45 PM, this date, regarding a conversation with a friend of his, one Robert Brinn, who told him that Charles Hierzi (ph), who runs the Lakewood Laundramat, had Oswald working for him in November, 1962.

According to Hierzi, Oswald was sent to him through the Texas Employment Commission.

Mr. Bernd stated that he was leaving on vacation Saturday, August 8, and would be in Macon, Ga. He said that he would return on September 14; but in the event the FBI needed to verify the story, Mr. Brinn could be reached at his office phone, Taylor 4-5172.
