Did TRULY or BAKER see anyone in the lunch room on the second floor When they encountered OSWALD there? Both TRULY and BAKER, as KALLEY recalled, ran up the steps and toward the little room and they saw someone through the glass door and they found O8Vands with a Coke and he walked out of the room through the office where the employees were not normally supposed to be. Did they see anyone else around in the lunch room at that time?

Dallas is requested to obtain ad go ed statments from both regarding that phase. BAKER can best be located through the Dali las Police Department. A lar. or Dr. GOLDBERG indicated he had talked to both Patrolman BAKER and" Mr. TRUNYyesterday:

When statements obtained, send to Bureau AM as quickly as possible, marked for the attention of Mr. BOSEN.

Mr. MaLLET also mentioned that the Bureau has made arrangements to obtain 100 copies of the Commission's report and that each Field Office will be furnished a copy. Dallas will receive 4 or 5 copies, be believed, and he stated it would not be necessary for the Field Offices to index the report.
