On 9/24/64 Mrs. HARRIS, 810 Bristol Pike, Croydon, Pa., telephonically contacted the Philadelphia Office and advised that recently she had been in Texas and while there visited a Mrs. CORA HAZELWOOD, Crosbyton, Tex. Mrs. HAZELWOOD related the story that she had been watching the parade of President KENNEDY on television when he visited Dallas, Tex. She said that just before President KENNEDY was shot, she saw what appeared to be a broomstick come out of the window of a building. She later learned this was the building from which the fatal shots were fired. The broomstick appeared, withdrew, reappeared, and then the shots were fired that killed President KENNEDY.
