COLONEL ALFRED GUS KRAGER, NOT KRAGEN, ADVISED TODAY THAT HE CAN NOT PLACE SUBJECT AND IF HE HAS HAD ANY ASSOCIATION WITH HIM IN THE PAST IT WAS NOTHING OF CONSEQUENCE. HE WAS UNABLE TO SUPPLY ANY INFORMATION CONCERNING SUBJECT. COLONEL KRAGER IS CHAIRMAN OF THE U. S. CITIZENS COMMITTEE, INC., CINCINNATI, A CIVIC AND PATRIOTIC ORGANIZATION WHICH, THROUGH ITS PROGRAMS BRINGS TO THE ATTENTION OF THE PUBLIC INFORMATION ABOUT GOVERNMENT. COLONEL KRAGER IS A WELL KNOWN PUBLIC SPEAKER AND HAS TRAVELED THROUGHOUT THE UNITED STATES. [REDACTED]
